**Do You Practice Good Pet-iquette?**

This subject has been covered in many previous newsletters but we continue to receive complaints from our residents about it. Here are just a few friendly reminders of how to be a polite and responsible pet owner.

- Keep your dog under control at all times. If you are walking your dog, it is the law that it must be on a leash. If you are at home, your dog must be on a leash or inside of fenced area. Not everyone may share your love of pets and may not want to be licked, loved or jumped on.
- Pick up after your pet. Again, its not just neighborly, it's the law. If your pet leaves waste it is your responsibility to pick up after your pet. Not only is it unpleasant to be walking in your yard and step in a pile of dog waste or digging in your flower bed and realize the cat has been there, it is unsanitary. Animal waste carries bacteria, viruses and parasites (including, but not limited to, salmonella and E.coli) and rainwater will wash it into our waterways.
- Even urine can damage shrubbery and leave brown spots on the lawn. Please remember that all homes are private property, so allowing your dog to urinate on someone's bushes isn't respectful and is basically property damage. Homeowners can seek legal action.

make sure that your real estate agent is aware of this policy.

Garage and yard sale signs must be removed as soon as the sale is over. Please refrain from using light poles in the neighborhood to display your signs. The adhesive is difficult to remove, which leaves the poles looking less than desirable and use of the light poles in this manner is against city law.

If you are placing your sign at the front entrance, please be aware that there are buried electrical and water lines. Under no circumstances will signs be allowed in the flower bed. If a sign is found in a flower bed, it will be removed and disposed of immediately.

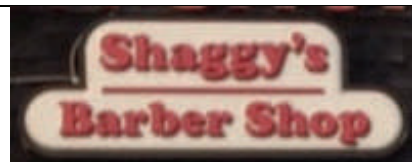
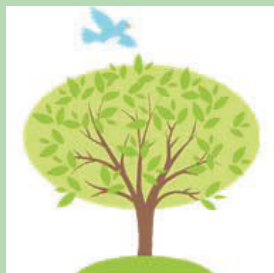
## Smart 9-1-1

This includes pruning or trimming any tree branches that hinder a 7-ft. clearance on sidewalks and 12-ft. clearance above street traffic (14-ft. for main roads such as Masterson Station Drive & Sandersville). It is also just as important to remove any that are below the 7-ft. line to insure proper tree health and growth
