SIGN, SIGNS, EVERYWHERE THERE'S SIGNS

Lexington has a law prohibiting the use of public land and right of ways for signs and posters. This includes For Sale by Owner and Realtor Signs, Open House Signs and Flyers posted on poles. Due to this policy in the city of Lexington, our Deed of Restrictions and to maintain the overall value of our neighborhood, these signs will be removed from the main entrance and any other "public" or neighborhood property. Understanding For Sale by Owners rely heavily on these signs and the potential positive influence sales in our neighborhood have on property values, For Sale and Open House signs will be left in place from 9am Friday to 9am Monday. Any signs left in public space on Monday at 9am will be removed and disposed of. Please pass this information along to your realtors as well, so they understand what will happen to their signs.

With that being said, there have been reports of real estate signs being removed before real estate agents have the opportunity to retrieve them. Open house signs have been seen being removed before the open house is over. These signs are not cheap. Please refrain from removing real estate signs that fall in the above time frame and aren't yours. As far as garage and yard sale signs go, please remember to take them down once your sale is over. Also, please refrain from using the light poles in the neighborhood to display your signs. The adhesive that is left from the tape being used is hard to get off the light poles and use of the light poles in such a matter is against city law.
